2021-2022 WINTER CLASS SCHEDULE I.U.O.E. LOCAL #132 TRAINING SITE

CDL CLASSES - Written: February 14-18, 2022 Driving: March 21 - April 1, 2022

Federal and State law requires anyone operating vehicles grossing 26,000 pounds or more on the highway (this includes rubber-tire cranes, motor graders, loaders, mechanics trucks, grease trucks, etc.) to have a Commercial Driver's License. This is an 80-hour class (2 weeks) preparing you to take the written exam, skills test and scheduling you to take both. *Participants attending this class are required to have a DOT Physical and present a completed Physical Form the first day of class.*

<u>CRANE & RIGGING CLASS</u> - November 29 – December 3, 2021, March 14-18, 2022 & April 11-15, 2022

This is a 40-hour class (1 week). This class will contain both hands-on and classroom training, and will include crane safety and load chart reading. Rigging training will include classroom and hands-on as well. **This is not a certification class**.

EXCAVATION & TRENCHING CLASS - November 1-5, 2021 & November 8-12, 2021

This is a 40-hour class (1 week). This class contains both hands-on and classroom training. This class will be pipeline oriented, as well as highway and utilities.

GPS DOZER/GRADER CLASS - October 18-22, 2021 & April 18 -22, 2022

This is a 40-hour class (1 week). This class will contain basic grade checking, cut grade slope with dozer, grader and excavator, functions of GPS controls, and software.

HAZ-MAT CLASS - January 10-14, 2022

This is a 40-hour class (1 week). This class is required for anyone that works at a hazardous waste job site. Also, many chemical plants and gas (pipeline) company owners are requiring this training.

HAZ-MAT REFRESHER - January 3-8, 2022

This 8 hour class is for members that have already taken the 40-hour class and are currently hazmat eligible. Federal Law requires that after taking the 40-hour class participants have an 8-hour annual refresher.

NCCCO WRITTEN TESTING - NCCCO Class: January 24-28, 2022 NCCCO Written Exam: January 29, 2022

OSHA 10 HOUR CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY CLASS - May 4-5, 2022

This is a 2 day class. You must attend both days of class in order to receive your certification card.

VACUUM PIPE LIFTER CLASS - To be announced at a later date.

This is a 40-hour class (1 week). The completion of this class will provide an evaluation card in accordance to ASME Standard B30.20-2013. An evaluation requires the operator to perform safety tests, inspections, and general maintenance procedures. Operators must be safe and proficient in the operation of the machine and lifter. *This is a specialty class, inquiries must be proficient excavator operators, and a crane background is a plus.

FORKLIFT CERTIFICATION

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has revised its existing requirements for powered industrial truck operator training and has issued new requirements to improve the training of these operators. Anyone wishing to obtain their forklift certification should call the training site to be scheduled. Forklift certification must be renewed every three years.

CRANE CERTIFICATION

According to OSHA all crane operators must be certified.

The National Commission for the Certification of Crane Operators (NCCCO) Examinations are competency-based examinations for crane operator reflective of crane operator knowledge and expertise for each of the specialties (Lattice Boom Crawler, Lattice Boom Truck, Telescopic Boom-Swing Cab, and Telescopic Boom-Fixed Cab). All candidates are required to pass both the written and practical examinations in order to be certified. Candidates must also meet CCO medical requirements. One thousand hours crane related experience is not required for new certifications. Anyone needing to schedule a practical examination, should contact the training site.
